Commands PRINTF and PRINBC

The new command PRINTF recently put into use (see CTSS Bulletin No. 38) is sufficiently large to fall into a lower-priority queue than the older PRINTF. Service is thus degraded, and since PRINTF is a frequently used command overall system performance may be affected.

Consequently, the old PRINTF will be reactivated as it was before July 17th. The newer command will be made available under the name PRINBC. Except for this renaming, everything will remain as outlined in CTSS Bulletin No. 38.

These modifications will be effective July 28, 1964.
