New code converter for teletypes and 1050's

Soon a new code conversion module will be placed into service. This module will consider the position of the carriage when inserting the tab and carriage return delay characters and insert a carriage return character when a line becomes full. In order for this module to work properly all 1050 tabs must be set uniformly. If the left margin is set at column 1 then the tabs should be set to columns 15, 30, 45, . . . .

The code table has also been changed to allow the backspace key to be used when typing memos and as a logical backspace key for use with EDIT. Its code is 135<sub>g</sub>.
