CTSS BULLETIN #1

The following changes in the Compatible Time-Sharing System will be effective on December 12, 1963:

- When at command level a line consisting of only a carriage return is ignored, rather than typing "NOT A COMMAND, TRY AGAIN".
- Whenever CTSS types, "READY" it will be followed by two carriage returns so that each command will be set off by a blank line.
- 3. Both modules on the disk will be used. Files will be written alternately on the modules.
- 4. The teletype output buffers have been doubled in size. This should improve the response time of users in some situations.
