Load Commands

The LØAD, LØADGØ, VLØAD, and NCLØAD commands have been modified so that the lowest entry point in each subprogram is placed in an even location. The length of the loader has not been changed.

NCLØAD will print a common assignment error message if any library subroutine is loaded which uses erasable.

LØAD, VLØAD, and NCLØAD call CHNCØM at the completion of successful loading.

The NEED comment has been fixed so that the names of all missing routines are printed.
