## EXTBSS Command

A new version of EXTBSS has been put into use, with the following improvements:

1. It allows up to 100 entries in a single subroutine;

2. It provides a third optional argument;

EXTBSS LIB FIL NAM

will create a file FIL BSS, which will contain a copy of the first BSS routine, with an entry NAM, found in the file LIB BSS. If NAM is omitted it is assumed to be FIL, as in the older version of EXTBSS.

3. It prints out comments for use if the user types only EXTBSS
