1. FILE Command

The FILE command has been corrected so that a leading tab is not suppressed on a line entered in manual mode in a data-class file.

2. LISTF Command

The LISTF command has been corrected so that sorting by date will occur properly.

3. FAPDBG

FAPDBG now uses tabs instead of spaces on output, whenever possible. The bug in the compare request (C) has been fixed. The compare request will not compare memory locations which were not loaded when the program was loaded. The old contents are now printed in addition to the new contents.

4. PM

The comment which is printed at the stop when STOPAT and TRA are used consecutively now prints the correct address of the stop.

5. Maximum Number of Users

The maximum number of logged-in users has been increased to 24 at M.A.C. and 16 at C.C.
