### CTSS Commands

**SPLIT** - A new version is in use, which deletes previous copies of files to be created (Read-only copies are not deleted). In addition, a comment gives a list of deleted files.

It is allowed to create a new file with the same name as the file being split. The original file is not deleted until the command is completed.

### Foreground Library

#### Correction

**DREAD** and (**TSH**) have been modified so that the reading buffer is blanked out before every new record is read. Thus, there will be no longer undesirable information transmitted to user's program, when the reading statement requests more words than contained in the file record (either fixed or variable length record).

#### Correction

Error in PM **STMAP** which caused omission of programs with names beginning in "I" has been corrected.
