## Identification

## Purpose

The cartologer contains the entry points for all primitives of core control, and governs the flow of control within core control.

## Introduction

The cartologer includes the splitter, the coalescer, the waitlister and the waker, as well as the paste which holds together the rest of core control. The design of the cartologer is logically quite straightforward, and is not elaborated upon in this iteration beyond what is said in Section BG.6.00. This section is skeletal at this stage of document iteration and design, and will be upgraded as the implementation progresses.
