Purpose

In order to make it easier for administrative commands to create, modify, and read personal identification files, this document changes them from PL/I structures to ascii text files. This means that administrative commands are simple interfaces to the edit and print commands, and in initial versions of Multics may even be dispensed with entirely.

<u>Change</u>

On page 4, lines 8 to the end of the "Implementation" section should be replaced by: "The segment is an ascii text file such as can be written by the Multics <u>edit</u> command. The text is in the following format:

password (up to 8 characters) <NL>

default project id (up to 24 characters) <NL>

name of person who may act as proxy <NL>

name of another person who may act as proxy <NL>
