Identification

delname R. J. Feiertag, S. Rosenbaum

Purpose

This routine deletes a name from a specified entry.

<u>Usage</u>

At command level:

delname <u>path</u>

As a subroutine:

call delname_(path, code);

dcl path char(*),

/*path of entry name to be deleted*/

code fixed bin(17); /*command system error code*/

The entry name specified in <u>path</u> is deleted. The name must not be the only name for the entry. Write permission is necessary in the directory of the entry.

Example

delname fred

The name "fred" is deleted from that entry in the working directory.

Implementation

<u>setpath</u> is called to break the path into a directory and an entry. ufo $\$ chname (BY.2.01) is called to perform the changes to the file system. If an error is detected it is reported by a call to command_error.
