Function of Entry:

To add a name (or names) to a given segment. Several names may be added at once by supplying an ascii file containing those names.

Calling Sequence for Entry:

call dls_an (name, newname);

call dls_an\$file (name, filename);

Declaration of Arguments:

dcl (name, newname, filename) char (*);

Description of Arguments:

name is the entry name of the segment to which the names are to be added. The working directory is used.

newname is a single name to be added.

filename is the (path or) entry name of an ascii file which contains a list of names separated by new line characters (blanks, commas and horizontal tabs are ignored - colons may not be used; see segment "scan", BE.17.21, description for details). The name "stop" is interpreted as a request to stop processing and return to command level.
