SUBJECT: PRLST

PRLST is a program designed to print FAP listing files on-line. More generally it can be used also to print line-marked files if the number of words in each line is less than or equal to  $14_{10}$ . PRLST is used as follows:

RESUME PRLST F1 F2  $\alpha$   $\beta$

where F1 is the primary file name

F2 is the secondary file name

There are two possibilities relative to the third and fourth parameters.

1. If line numbers are to be printed

$\alpha$  = "LINE#"

then if it is desired to start printing at a line that has a particular symbolism the location field or at particular octal location

$\beta$  = symbol or octal location.

2. If line numbers are not to be printed then  $\alpha$  is the  $\beta$  described above.
3.  $\alpha$  and/or  $\beta$  may be omitted.
