As was discussed several weeks ago at the Multics Planning Meeting there is some documentation that is available on-line to all users that should probably be made available in hard copy format as well. In particular there are five info segments describing Version 2 PL/I that with minimal work (mostly deletion) would be useful documentation.

The info segment is:

v2p11  
v2p11.convert  
v2p11.hints

I would recommend that the first two be combined as one IPC document aimed towards prospective PL/I users and the last three be combined as a second document that is aimed to actual PL/I users. If the IPC has no personnel to perform this task we would be happy to do the necessary editing and running off in whatever format you specify.
