Thank you for your letter of March 12, 1975, relating to the fact that performance improvement on Multics has taken place in overhead quantities rather than "user state" items. Following our meeting on March 10, I made exactly the same calculation as you did for all paying MIT users and am showing the results in the attachment. As you can see, the figures are not substantially different from yours and confirm the point you made; namely, that the performance improvement which Roger Roach's measurement scripts show to be approximately a factor of 2 over the last eighteen months has in fact been primarily in overhead quantities diminished.

There is a rather interesting phenomenon that I discovered in digging out these data; namely, that the pattern of usage of the third shift changed drastically during calendar 1974. For example, in March 1974 (probably our busiest month), in which there was significant pressure on the first and even on the second shift, usage on the third shift was generating an average on-line charge of \$12.86 per console hour, or about \$1.00 per hour more than the first shift despite the substantial rate differential. This, I think, reflects two facts. Firstly, people who are here during the third shift are serious; i. e. they are using their consoles continuously, not just leaving them dialed in and using them occasionally. Secondly, people with expensive computing to do sometimes wait for the third shift when the rates were lowest. As the load decreased during calendar 1974, the average charge on the third shift also decreased, falling to \$9.80 per console hour in June, \$5.10 in September, and \$4.77 in November. In fact, during early calendar 1974, we had the very strange situation of the shift with the highest prices (i. e. the first) generating the lowest costs per console hour. It may not be too surprising when you think about it, but I suspect few of us would have guessed that this was the case.
