For your information, a third 103E data station or cabinet is needed when the number of trunks on "8" are increased from 48 to 64. At the present time there are 2 - 103E stations at T.S. One cabinet has all 40 data sets in use, and the other has 36 in use. The order for a third 103E is also held-up in line with the above.
