Re: Expansion of the data switch

I believe it will be necessary to expand the data switch in accordance with Jerry Saltzer's letter of April 6. This, I understand, entails increasing the number of trunks on the 8th level from 48 to 64.

In addition, it also seems advisable to continue with his recommendations to order an additional 103E for the Multics system. Since the lead time is so long, our unanswered questions on location, etc. cannot hold up the order.

The last paragraph of your April 24 letter still cannot be answered, but we're working on it.

Please let me know when you get some promise dates from the phone company.
