As I indicated in our telephone conversation of November 20th, this is a tentative order to you for the following equipment:

The data sets are to be equipped with busy-out switches. And, the frames are to be so arranged that they can accommodate the associated data access arrangements (F-58118) or the newer Model 1001B data coupler unit (CBT), depending upon whichever contact interface unit is available from the New England Telephone Co. (NET).

I would like to set January 29, 1971 as the tentative in-service date for the above. This should allow NET the opportunity to acquire the appropriate number of contact interface units; and, to make other changes that I'll be ordering through them in connection with this overall job.

It should be noted that the number of data sets shown above are planned to be increased to 200 in late 1971.

An official M.I.T. purchase order shall be issued to Tuck Electronics upon receipt of a recomputed purchase/installation price for the above equipment by this office from you. If I recall our conversation of November 20th, you indicated that based on the above, it would be necessary to recompute
