Relative to the computered busy-out, this is a standard feature of the 1033AA and will be on all units furnished to you.

Full maintenance is available on a \$1.00/mo./data set basis if you desire. This can be supplied essentially on site from National Data Communications Systems in Somerville, or we can make arrangements for an on-campus representative if you desire.

You will have five sets of spare cards on hand, and these will be used to provide immediate resumption of service. Card maintenance will be provided from Harrisburg on a replacement basis.

We will be pleased to conduct a free one- or two-day seminar at our facility for such M.I.T. people as you desire to send to us.

If we maintain the cards for you, there is a flat \$10.00 fee for any card.

National Data will also provide service on a per call basis if you desire.
