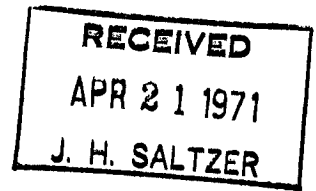

In view of the fact that we plan, what we believe to be, a sufficient "mapping" of data set-to adapter-to console connections, I do not see, at this time, any reason to acquire the indicator lights referred to by Jerry Saltzer.

In addition the cost of \$1,300 which would be required to adjust the Multics lines is prohibitive.
