Subject: Dartmouth System and Basic Documentation

Since the Dartmouth System and Basic compiler are largely proprietary programs of Dartmouth College, there is a question as to whether or not writeups should appear in the MPM or SPS. I propose that we go ahead and document this system in the MPM and SPS, with the notation "Installation Maintained Library" in place of "Development System". Since it is becoming necessary for MPM and SPS updates to be filtered before release to other installations anyway*, the Dartmouth writeups can be filtered out also.
