HARDWARE. ED Kleinow

-All priority hardware bugs/deficiencies have been fixed. Some processor FCO's are still outstanding. All of these are short (1 hour to install). Kleinow will coordinate installation with Rvan.

-DSS190 - Problem with head alignment has been taken care of. A cable in the area 2 unit has been shorting out. FED will replace it.

-Memory C - two parity errors occurred last week. Checkout showed 1 signal out of spec. FED located deficient potentiometer on mother board, replaced it and it ran okay.

-FCO - 14 hours received last week
