- Processors . Failing bit in SCUC - ST.A (Proc. A)  
FED spared out bit.
- . FED has been replacing CACHE CD boards at the  
request of engineering.
- PRT301 . STRIKER replaced in printer. Failing board in  
controller also replaced.
- Bulk Store . CSM memory board burned! FED replaced package  
and returned damaged board to Phoenix for analysis.
- DSU190 . Area 3 problems. Several channel address failures.  
FED will check this out.
- FED Coverage. Kleinow has a tentative schedule for FED coverage  
on 3rd shift. Leo says FED can start immediately.
