HARDWARE - S. D. Sprague

DSU190

- . Tracking servo head in unit 16 failed. Caused 1 system crash. FED replaced board and unit came up okay.

Processors

- . CPU A had cache storage parity error causing crash.

MTH500

- . Write error rate on unit 6 is excessive. FED will work on this as time permits.

CRZ201

- . FED replaced regulator board on card reader.

SOFTWARE - P. B. Kelley

- . System 30.4 running.
- . UNLOCK_DIR. suspected software crash. Users process expected to see his directory locked. It wasn't.
- . New fortran compiler installed. Fortran I/O has caused compatibility problems with (previous) Fortran compiler users. CISL has agreed to provide additional Fortran I/O which is compatible with previous Fortran.

OTHER

- . FED indicates that hardware availability for maintenance is sufficient.
- . FCO for 3.5 hours is to be installed. FED to schedule this time with Leo Ryan.
- . FED reviewed past performance during last FORUM meeting and indicated that they would strive for performance of not more than 3 system crashes per week, related to hardware, during the coming year. During a ten week period in the September - December time frame the average was 6 crashes per week!
