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Addition to Monthly Status Report

The Monthly Status Report shall include the following financial information:

- 1. Expenditures for the reporting period showing the amounts spent for each of manpower and material/equipment.
- 2. Cumulative expenditures from the award of the contract through the end of the reporting period.
- 3. Amount of funds remaining on contract.

The Contractor shall provide two graphs of expenditures on each Monthly Status Report. These graphs shall each plot money in \$10,000 intervals (y-axis) versus time in months (x-axis). Each graph shall plot expenditures for individual months. The second graph shall plot cumulative expenditures from contract award until the end of each month.

Amplification for Systems Manual

Paragraph 2.c.2 is amplified to include a precise functional specification for the programmed operation of the system. This specification shall include, but need not be limited to, descriptions of addressing modes and of the function of individual operations sufficient for the construction of system software.

The contractor shall produce the "6000 IU Functional Specification" in two separate volumes.

The first volume shall be in the format of a complete specification; however, it may as appropriate reference the second volume. The first volume shall be marked with distribution statement A, IAW AFR 80-45.

The second volume is intended to contain those engineering specifications and other proprietary information relating to the 6000/Series 60 interface and component connections that are proprietary to Honeywell, Inc. The second volume shall be marked with distribution statement B, Proprietary Information, IAW AFR 80-45.

ALLOWABLE COST AND PAYMENT (1974 APR)

- (a) The allowability of costs incurred in the performance of this contract shall be determined by the Contracting Officer in accordence with:
- (i) Part 2 of Section XV of the Armed Services Procurement Regulation in effect on the date of this contract; and
 - (ii) the terms of this contract.
- (b) Payments shall be made to the Contractor when requested as work progresses, but not more frequently than bi-weekly, in amounts approved by the Contracting Officer. The Contractor may submit to an authorized representative of the Contracting Officer, in such form and reasonable detail as such representative may require, an invoice or public voucher supported by a statement of cost for the performance of this contract and claimed to constitute allowable cost. For this purpose, except as provided herein with respect to pension contributions, the term "costs" sahll include only those recorded costs which result, at the time of the request for reimbursement, from payment by cash, check, or other form of actual payment for items or services purchased directly for the contract, together with (when the Contractor is not delinquent in payment of costs of contract performance in the ordinary course of business) costs incurred, but not necessarily paid, for materials which have been issued from the Contractor's stores inventory and placed in the production process for use on the contract, for direct labor, for direct travel, for other direct inhouse costs, and for properly allocable and allowable indirect costs, as is shown by records maintained by the Contractor for purposes of obtaining reimbursement under Government contracts plus the amount of progress payments which have been paid to Contractor's subcontractors under similar cost stand-In addition, when pension contributions are paid by the Contractor to the retirement fund less frequently than quaterly, accrued costs therefor shall be excluded from indirect costs for payment purposes until such costs are paid. If pension contributions are paid on a quarterly or more frequent basis, accruals therefor may be included in indirect costs for payment purposes provided that they are paid to the fund within thirty (30) days after the close of the period covered. If payments are not made to the fund within such thirty-day period, pension contribution costs shall be excluded from indirect cost for payment purposes until payment has been made. The restruction on payment more frequently than bi-weekly and the requirement of prior payment for items or services purchased directly for the contract shall not apply where the Contractor is a small business concern.
 - (c) Promptly after receipt of each invoice or voucher and statement of cost, the Government shall, except as otherwise provided in this contract, subject to the provisions of (d) below, make payment

thereon as approved by the Contracting Officer. After payment of an amount equal to eighty percent (80%) of (the Government's share of) the total estimated cost of performance of this contract set forth in the Schedule, the Contracting Officer may withhold further payment on account of allowable cost until a reserve shall have been set aside in an amount which he considers necessary to protect the interests of the Government, but such reserve shall not exceed one percent (1%) of (the Government's share of) such total estimated cost or one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000), whichever is less.

- (d) At any time or times prior to final payment under this contract, the Contracting Officer may have the invoices or vouchers and statements of cost audited. Each payment theretofore made shall be subject to reduction for amounts included in the related invoice or voucher which are found by the Contracting Officer on the basis of such audit, not to constitute allowable cost. Any payment may be reduced for overpayments, or increased for underpayments, on preceding invoices or vouchers.
- (e) On receipt and approval of the invoice or voucher designated by the Contractor as the "completion invoice" or "completion voucher" and upon compliance by the Contractor with all the provisions of this contract (including, without limitation, the provisions relating to patents and the provisions of (f) below), the Government shall promptly pay to the Contractor any balance of allowable cost, which has been withheld pursuant to (c) above or otherwise not paid to the Contractor. The completion invoice or voucher shall be submitted by the Contractor promptly following completion of the work under this contract but in no event later than one (l) year (or such longer period as the Contracting Officer may in his discretion approve in writing) from the date of such completion.
- (f) The Contractor agrees that any refunds, rebates, credits, or other amounts (including any interest thereon) accruing to or received by the Contractor or any assignee under this contract shall be paid by the Contractor to the Government, to the extent that they are properly allocable to costs for which the Contractor has been reimbursed by the Government under this contract. Reasonable expenses incurred by the Contractor for the purpose of securing such refunds, rebates, credits, or other amounts shall be allowable costs hereunder when approved by the Contracting Officer. Prior to final payment under this contract, the Contractor and each assignee under this contract whose assignment is in effect at the time of final payment under this contract shall execute and deliver:
 - (i) an assignment to the Government, in form and substance satisfactory to the Contracting Officer, of refunds, rebates, credits, or other amounts (including any inter-

est thereon) properly allocable to costs for which the Contractor has been reimbursed by the Government under this contract; and

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- (ii) a release discharging the Government, its officers, agents and employees from all liabilities, obligations, and claims arising out of or under this contract, subject only to the following exceptions:
 - (A) specified claims in stated amounts or in estimated amounts where the amounts are not susceptible of exact statement by the Contractor;
 - (B) claims, together with reasonable expenses incidental thereto, based upon liabilities of the Contractor to third parties arising out of the performance of this contract; provided, that such claims are not known to the Contractor on the date of the execution of the release; and provided further that the Contractor gives notice of such claims in writing to the Contracting Officer not more than six (6) years after the date of the release or the date of any notice to the Contractor that the Government is prepared to make final payment, whichever is earlier; and
 - (C) claims for reimbursement of costs (other than expenses of the Contractor by reason of his indemnification of the Government against patent liability), including reasonable expenses incidental thereto, incurred by the Contractor under the provisions of this contract relating to patents.
- (g) Any cost incurred by the Contractor under the terms of this contract which would constitute allowable cost under the provisions of this clause shall be included in determining the amount payable under this contract, notwithstanding any provisions contained in the specifications or other documents incorporated in this contract by reference, designating services to be performed or materials to be furnished by the Contractor at his expense or without cost to the Government.
