Mr. Ed Thele and his boss, Mr. R. A. Decker [T + D Manager, 600-line] would like (provision for) the following in MULTICS.

- Some kind of data on peripheral error rate accounting-as you said Tuesday-by device name.
- 2) Peripheral "timer runout" check, i.e. no reply in n seconds causes a fault trap.
- 3) Periodic scheduled checks on certain devices i. e. two TTYs back-to-back.
- 4) Withdrawal from available pool, of non-essential units on demand, including peripherals, memory controllers, processors.
 - 5) Allocate a peripheral on demand to GE Peripheral Optional Operating Program (GEPOOP is part of the conventional T + D package).

These features might well be useful to me_too.
