Dear Gary:

When we last talked about the preliminary drafts of space, equipment, and personnel budgets, there were two or three items which I was unsure about, and promised to review with Corby. We have now checked and agree on the following:

- 1. Meyer, Tavares, and Pogran (and their floor space) should be shown as 100% Computer Networks, and no allocation to Computer System Research. You already have Padlipsky and Kanodia shown as 100% Computer Networks, which is correct.
- 2. The consoles, data lines, and data sets located in rooms 507 and 508 should be charged 100% to Computer Networks, and 0% to Computer System Research. (The initial draft charged 100% to both groups.)
- 3. Rooms 501, 504, and 33% of 505, which are occupied by Information Processing Center employees, should be charged to Multics Operations, to be recovered from the Information Processing Center. The rooms occupied by HISI employees should not be charged to Multics operations. The HISI employees are guests of the CSR group, working on Multics development rather than Multics operations, and are properly charged to CSR.

With these changes, I then come up with the following summary:
