Systems Programmer's Introduction to Multics

Being written.

Contains two major sections; one discusses Multics concepts and their implementation (theory), the other provides a practical "how to" set of programming examples and tips (practice).

- Interim Multics Operations Manual

Being written.

A compilation of the procedures an operator at a Multics site must know to start, run, and shutdown Multics.

FORTRAN

Except for a missing section on 1/0, this is in review.

- MCG

Though listed as published, this manual is subject to continuing revision and will always be a "work in progress".

- Multics User Procedures

Being written.

A sequel to the MCG which covers the Multics primatives. This will also probably be a "work in progress" after publication.

VOCAB

Exists in outdated form.

It seems inevitable under present circumstances that this must be regarded as a "dead" project. Unless more people are available and the files can be moved from Phoenix, there is little point in attempting to maintain VOCAB.
