

The index to the System Programmers' Supplement of the Multics Programmers' Manual contains an entry for local generate procedure which is one of the Multics system. In addition there are unspecified entries for multilevel memory features as added to the system and functions like workcopy for generation and intercopy. These have been renamed, or deleted, but remain as described.

Note that \*1 and \*5 entries should not exist. All efforts should be made to eliminate such entries by either issuing new documentation or bringing old documentation up to date.
