The index to the System Programmers' Supplement of the Multics Programmers' Manual contains an entry for each separate procedure which is part of the Multics system. In addition certain cross-referenced entries for similar or related procedures are added to point to findings the words apply for uniformity and consistency. Some have the same name, or entry, but want as described.

If an entry in the index contains the word "obsolete" it is to be deleted. The date the latest revision of the document was issued and a brief phrase indicating subject matter of the system the procedure is closely associated with.

The documentation status indicates the current state of the documentation for the procedure. The following separate status conditions are differentiated:

The procedure is not doc-

The procedure is not documented and probably never will be because the procedure itself is obsolete.

*3

The procedure is documented. However the document is not up to date and a revision is in the process of being generated.

*4

The procedure is not documented. However an initial version of the document is being generated.

*5

The procedure is documented but the documentation is not up to date. There is no revision currently being generated.

Note that *1 and *5 entries should not exist. All efforts should be made to eliminate such entries by either issuing new documentation or bringing old documentation up to date.
