Dear Mr. Burlingame,

Returned herewith is an executed copy of your letter of November 23, 1970, by which MIT consents to the delegation of General Electric's duties under the basic Agreement between MIT and General Electric. We have assumed in executing this document that the reference to the Agreement "as revised April 22, 1968" should be interpreted as reading "of April 22, 1968, as revised" in order to include Amendment No. 1, dated July 21, 1969, and Amendment No.2, effective as of January 1, 1970.

We have also executed this document on the understanding that it has no effect on the separate Agreement relating to patentable inventions and other intellectual property dated November 5, 1965, as amended. We assume that the latter Agreement can be appropriately revised at the conclusion of current discussions between representatives of General Electric and Honeywell Information Systems, Inc., including Messrs. Elgroth, Manbeck, and Jacobs, and Mr. R.J. Horn, representing MIT.
