Authority is granted on the basis of:

1. Procedure (Segment)
2. Human Being
3. User Account
4. Process

## Typical Authorities:

1. To use system
2. To leave files in secondary storage
3. To explore secondary storage  
class 1 any directory  
class 2 (print files)
4. To modify flexible supervisor.
5. To patch hardware supervisor
6. To call for reconfiguration
7. To reflect change to a different account
8. To examine and modify accounting files.
9. To be an "operator"
10. To decree <sup>the</sup> secondary storage location of a file.
11. To change authorities
12. To inhibit some class of interrupts.

13. To be used as a data base by an accounting routine.

14. To call the accounting procedure.
