SUBJECT: Transactor--GIM Interface

- 1. From outside the GIM, $\underline{\text{channels}}$ are not visible; people are using $\underline{\text{devices}}$.
- 2. Access control for devices is set in the Registry Files. Access information concerning a given device may be found by a call \underline{to} the Registry File Maintainer. The format of the call is not known.
- 3. The notion of $\underline{\text{logical channel}}$ may be useful inside the GIM. But from outside the GIOC, this notion is irrelevant.
 - 4. Possibly the GIM wants to receive a call

from the RFM. That is more reasonable.
