delname

Purpose

This routine deletes a name from a specified entry.

Usage

At command level:

```
delname path
```

As a subroutine:

```
call delname_(path, code);  
dcl path char(*), /*path of entry name to be  
deleted*/  
code fixed bin(17); /*command system error code*/
```

The entry name specified in path is deleted. The name must not be the only name for the entry. Write permission is necessary in the directory of the entry.

Example

```
delname fred
```

The name "fred" is deleted from that entry in the working directory.

Implementation

setpath is called to break the path into a directory and an entry. ufo\$chname (BY.2.01) is called to perform the changes to the file system. If an error is detected it is reported by a call to command_error.
