command\_error

Purpose

Command\_error is an error handling routine provided primarily for the use of file system commands to print a meaningful comment given a file system error code.

Usage

```
        call command_error (code, string);  
or     call command_error (code);  
where code is fixed binary and string is a character  
string.
```

Implementation

Command\_error will look up the code in fscodedinfo and print a message of the form

```
error message
```

if a string is not provided to command\_error, or of the form

```
error message: string
```

if a string is provided.

Error message is a character string of the form

```
error 3528
```

if the code is not found in fscodedinfo, or

```
noentry
```

if the code is found

Examples

```
noentry:    >system_library>zilch  
error 2023: invalid string  
noaccess
```
