I'm sorry for not doing a little more writing but I have been busy as usual. I think you understand.

As you can see by my new return address I am in another Regiment, although it is still the same Division. They needed some officers in the 133 with combat experience so I was sent over. As far as him concerned it's still the same old war to me. I'm getting pretty damned tired of this war, eight months of fighting in the infantry is long enough for any man.

I received a letter from one of you even 3 or 4 days and they are very encouraging, keep them coming. I hope you haven't forgotten the sandline or clam canister I asked for on the size 150 film. Write soon and don't forget my new address
