NAMES (memo) is an alphabetical TYPSET file in my problem number T263 3492 which is presently permitted to M1416 \* and T193. Each typset line normally lists the NAME, EXTENSION, ROOM, GROUP, PROBNO and PROGNO of users of the MAC system.

The file is designed for two purposes: 1) to output by RUNOFF the Project MAC alphabetical telephone list in such a way that only NAME, EXTENSION and ROOM appear on the hard copy; and 2) to select--by TYPSET change instructions--various sets of GROUP, PROBNO and PROGNO information helpful in monitoring use of the system and in administering the project.

In general, a NAME is repeated if there is more than one GROUP or PROBNO for any person. Some devices appear at the beginning of some typset lines to prevent their being printed in the RUNOFF of the telephone directory:

- 1) .\* to indicate other line(s) with the same NAME precede this line
- 2) .? to indicate currently I have some question about this line of information
- 3) .-- to indicate a line with only PROBNO and PROGNO

Other devices within the typset line are to help in interpreting any selection of information:

- 4) ( indicates no known problem number
- 5) ) indicates no known programmer number
- 6) + after programmer number indicates there is another problem number registered to this programmer--print the next line for it
- 7) (PROBNO tab PROGNO) indicates the problem number registered to another name but this person sometimes acts for the registered user

The first line of the file describes the tab stop settings. I have attached a copy of this line and some examples to illustrate the devices in the file.

Suggestions and assistance are most welcome. Call extension 5854. I will keep a hard copy of the latest revision of the total file, as well as off-line versions with NAME alphabetically, and PROBLEM NUMBER and PROGRAMMER NUMBER sequentially.
