SUBJECT: ONLINE INSTALLATION CHANGES

The following is a list of changes to the standard service system, maintenance tools, author maintained and installation maintained libraries for the week beginning March 25, 1974.

HOW TO READ THIS LISTING:

Each modification is preceded by the MCR number covering it (if there is one), and a brief explanation of the change.

This information is followed by the name of the object segment, help file, include file, or bound segment (or group of the above) involved in the modification.

Also given is the date and time of installation, and the name of the system library to which the change was made.

For bound segments, a list of the components follows, as well as the action which was taken with regard to each component.

An explanation does not accompany the listing of a segment which was "de-installed", or removed because of some problem, but the original installation information may be considered inoperative.
