SUBJECT: DEVELOPMENT MACHINE PRIORITY

This MSB obsoletes MCB-857

The following priority list shall be used as a guide to the scheduling of the 645 Development Machine. The sign-up system currently in effect will continue to be used; however, when necessary, people working on projects of lower priority may need to be rescheduled.

The priorities are as follows:

1. Repair of hardware or software problems that affect 645 Service performance or reliability.
2. Software development to complete Phase II of the Storage System Enhancements project.
3. Software development on the 645 that is required as part of the plan for 645F Multics but must be done on the 645.
4. Software or Hardware development to integrate the Bulk Store.
5. Software Development that is part of Storage System Enhancements Phase III, the "low cost" service project, or the the Tape software project.
6. All other projects.
