Multics Documentation for Multics Release 3.1

Documentation of MR 3.1 for customer use is started as of this date. Input for all documentation is now due from all CISL personnel who have the responsibility for developing 3.1 enhancements. The final date for submitting new input is FW552; however, the majority of your input must be submitted well in advance of that date.

The attached list details the documentation effort for MR 3.1 and MR 4.0. In the case of all customer documentation for which CISL assumes responsibility, the following procedure is established:

- 1. Five (5) months before release date, an MTR will be issued outlining the System Release Documentation schedule for each affected document. Documentation necessary to support the release, if not already underway, will start on that date.
- Approximately three (3) months before release date, technical review of the documentation will start. Final technical changes can be made at this time without adverse effect on delivery of the documentation with the system release.
- 3. Software developers must bear in mind that submittal of draft documentation does <u>not</u> completely fulfill their responsibility. Careful review of final draft of documentation to ensure customer needs are filled is also the developer's responsibility.

The Program Logic Manuals (PLMs) that will be produced by CISL during this period are not reflected in the attached lists. The PLM document list will be re-evaluated in the future and a new schedule established for those documents that remain to be published.

The following lists reflect documentation requirements through MR 4.0. The first list describes documents to which CISL is committed and which must be produced within the indicated

Multics Project internal working documentation. Not to be reproduced or distributed outside the Multics Project.

schedule in order to meet AFDSC requirements (contractual commitment). The second and third lists show documents required to support software for Multics Release 3.1 and 4.0 respectively.

Significant dates reflected on the attached lists assume the following release dates:

Multics Release 3.1 -- FW 613 Multics Release 4.0 -- FW 626

For releases 3.1 and 4.0 documentation, certain milestones must be observed in order to have the support documents available on time for the release.

- 3. Go to printer FW 604 (allows 8 weeks for printing, but we'll pressure for 6).
- 4. Printed documents available FW 611.

## For MR 4.0:

- 1. MTR issued FW 606 (writing starts here).
- 2. Final review starts FW 614.
- 3. Go to printer FW 616 (allows 8 weeks for printing but we'll ask for 6).
- 4. Printed documents available FW 624.
