MPC500 -- Memory chip failed. Firmware would load but MPC would not work. FED replaced chip.

MTH500 -- Additional MTH505's have not been installed. FED (Kleinow) says the drives are running the way they should. T/D's do not show any problem areas. IPO (Daley) feels that the (expletive deleted) drives are not running with the write reliability that MIT needs.
