## Hardware-E.D. Kleinow

### \*Processors-

- . CPU-B had cache related parity errors. FED replaced cache memory board.
- . 24 hours of FCO's (12 each processor) are outstanding. About half of these FCO's relate to op-not-complete and EIS problems.
- . Apparent problem with associative memory. FED checked boards but no failures were encountered. D. Jordan feels this problem is a CPU-B problem.

### \*Bulk Store-

- . Damaged chip replaced. Suspected air-conditioning problem. Failure occurred after power up from A/C shut down.

### \*DN355-

- . HSLA problem, FED replaced failing board.

### \*PRT 301-

- . Hood problem. Sensing switches have been ordered for replacement.
