Subject: Undergraduate Student Use of Multics

Professor M. M. Jones has spoken to several other professors here at MAC and they have arrived at the following guidelines for undergraduate student use of Multics:

- 1) Projects must contribute to the improvement of Multics System.
- 2) Projects require prior approval of either Professor F. J. Corbató or Mr. R. C. Daley.
- 3) Usage of off-shift time will be encouraged but will not be made mandatory.
- 4) Office space and consoles will be provided at MAC.

Implicit in the above are two further points:

- 1) Only a few positions will be open.
- 2) MAC can pay student wages during the summer.
