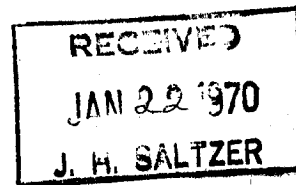

Dear Wes:

Your note of January 12 to Bob Daley expressed concern over the proposed connection of the ARPA network to Multics. Let me assure you that there is no intent of allowing unmetered and unpaid use of Multics. Instead the general plan is that there will be an account for ARPA network use which MAC will pay for. Although this account will have some limits set by the MAC administration, a probable initial policy would be for first-come-first-served usage.
