SUBJECT: Transactor--GIM Interface

1. From outside the GIM, channels are not visible; people are using devices.

2. Access control for devices is set in the Registry Files. Access information concerning a given device may be found by a call to the Registry File Maintainer. The format of the call is not known.

3. The notion of logical channel may be useful inside the GIM. But from outside the GIOC, this notion is irrelevant.

4. Possibly the GIM wants to receive a call

alloted (device, userid)

from the RFM. That is more reasonable.
